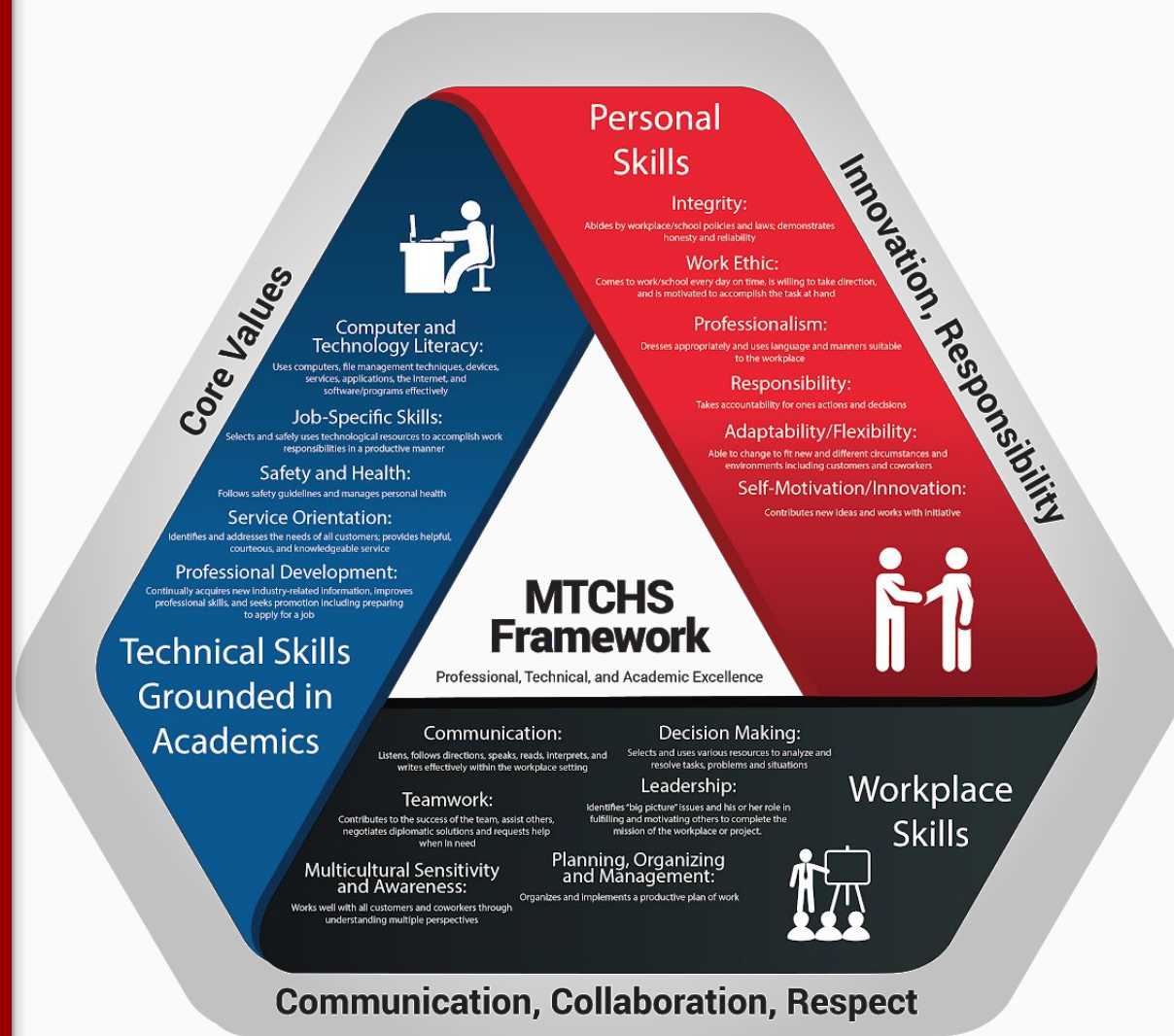

Adaptability/Flexibility:

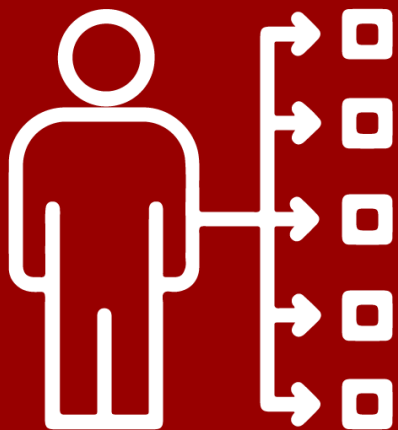
Able to change to fit new and different circumstances and environments including customers and coworkers

Multicultural Sensitivity and Awareness:

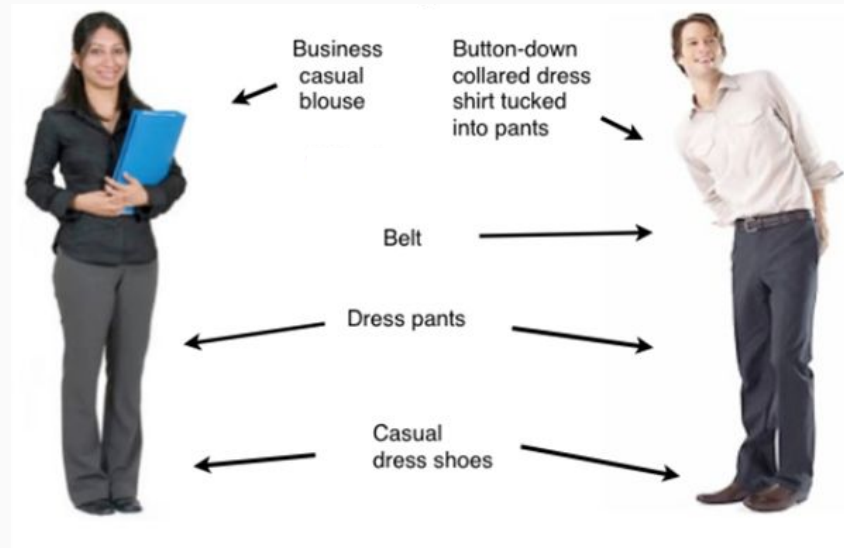
Works well with all customers and coworkers through understanding multiple perspectives

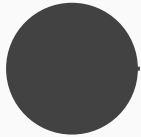

How It Works

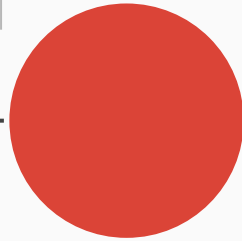
Step 1

Hone your craft all through your high school career.



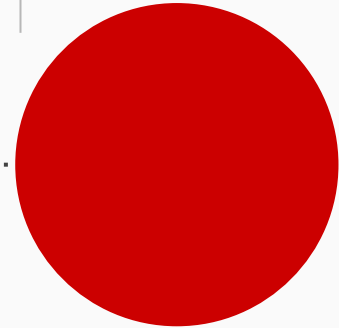
Step 2

Get an internship. (Go to interviews, prepare cover letters, etc.)



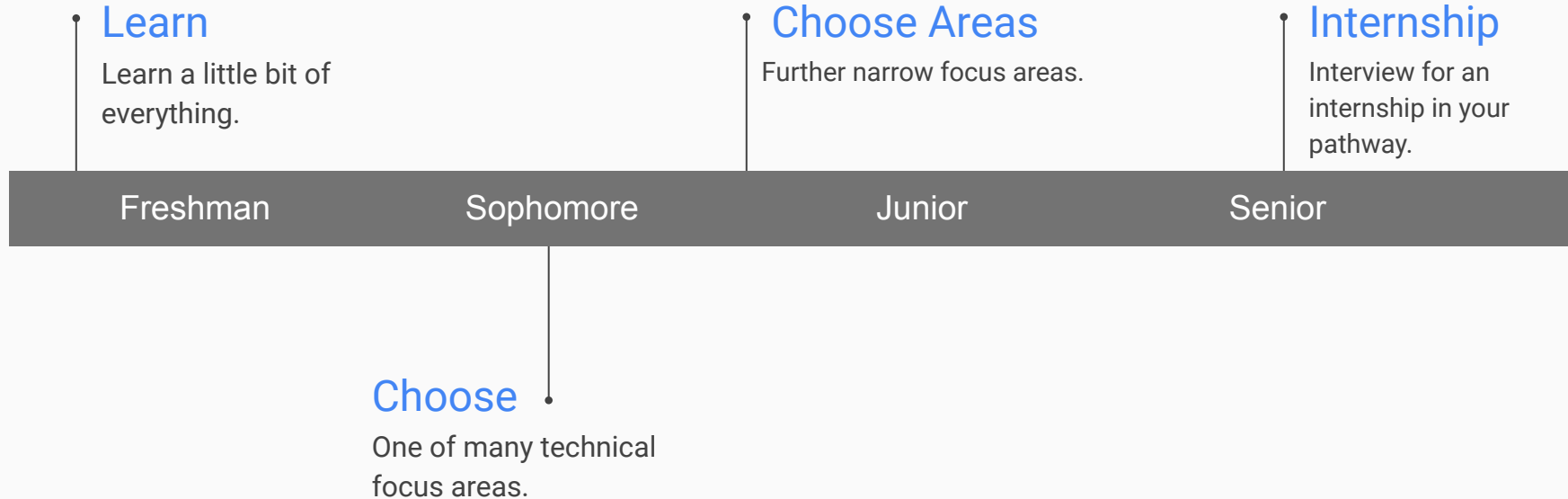
Step 3
