Such support may come in the form of money, personal 12 13 services, real or personal property and/or any combination of the aforementioned. 14 Companies wishing to provide support to the district in exchange for acknowledgement 15 or advertising consideration may only do so with the approval of the board of trustees: 16 however, booster and extracurricular program support acknowledgement in and on the 17 districts' fields, stadiums, fencing, scoreboards and in printed programs require approval 18 of the building principal. 19 20 Any gift, donation or bequest which exceeds a fair market value of \$15,000 must have 21 board approval. Such donation or support, upon formal transfer to the district, shall 22 become the property of Joint School District No. 2. Every effort will be made to insure 23 that a gift or donation designated for a specific district program or purpose will be utilized 24 as the donor desires. Any gift, etc., less than a fair market value of \$15,000 shall be 25 governed by the administrative regulations of the superintendent and by any applicable 26 state and federal laws. 27 28 Acknowledgement of the donor will be made in an appropriate fashion by the 29 board of trustees. A gift or donation will not be accepted if an acknowledgement 30 restriction or condition is placed on it by the donor. 31 32 The board of trustees shall insure that all gifts, grants, donations and bequests meet or 33 exceed the district's standards, philosophy and operating parameters. 34 35 Equipment/supplies acquired through a grant is the property of the school district.
